

CHEK receives a small amount of money for limited assistance to registered students. Parents of registered students are requested to submit receipts for reimbursement of small educational purchases. Your *registration or re-registration form* must be on file at the CHEK office by September 30th to be eligible for reimbursement. The school year runs July 1st to June 30th.

Guidelines for Reimbursement

- \$150 is allocated to each registered student in grades K-12 for curriculum/activities.
- Receipts must be dated between July 1st and May 31st of the current school year.
- Please submit receipts between November 1st and May 31st in order to receive the reimbursement. Allow 2-4 weeks for claims to be processed.
- Receipts may only be submitted once for reimbursement.
- The Reimbursement Form must be filled out and submitted along with copies or original receipts.
- Parents may submit receipts for educational curriculum/resources & activities, eg:
 - Textbooks, workbooks, readers, novels
 - school/art supplies,
 - music lessons,
 - sports fees,
 - tutoring fees,
 - Internet fees (please submit copy of a paid bill)
 - student entrance fees to museums, art galleries, theatre productions, & educational exhibits
- CHEK will not accept receipts for reimbursement of items that are considered equipment or non-consumable items such as microscopes, electronics, sports equipment, furniture, storage containers, tools, etc.
- Families with enrolled and registered students will still submit receipts for the registered portion of the resource funds allotted to them.
- Any remaining funds cannot be carried over to the next school year.

Rosetta Stone

Registered students may use their funds to access online languages with Rosetta Stone through CHEK. Licenses are \$109 per student. The following languages are available:
French, Spanish, German, Italian, Russian, American English

CHEK receives a weekly literacy resource called NEWSprint, www.eduserve.biz. Newsprint is a weekly current events publication. It includes articles from all over the world, and has related web links where

students could go for more information. NEWSprint contains subject related extension activities in the areas of Math, LA, Social Studies, and Science. Activities are also geared for students needing adaptation to their studies, or for students who like to extend their learning into further areas of research. This publication can easily be included into the regular studies of a student learning at home.
